Amasan an sgeama:

Thèid pròiseictean am measadh à reir na tomhasan a leanas. Thèid pròiseictean am maoinachadh a:

- leudachas inbhe na Gàidhlig aig an Oilthigh.
- chruthachas cothroman gus Gàidhlig a chleachdadh aig an Oilthigh.
- chruthachas no neartachas ceangalan ri buidhnean coimhearsnachd.
- tha ùr, ùr-ghnàthach, no a chuireas ri tachartas no pròiseict gus na h-amasan gu h-àrd a choileanadh.

Bidh pròiseactan soirbheachail a chleachdas am maoinachadh a th' ann san dòigh às èifeachdaich. Bu chòir tagraichean a bhith soilleir mu ciamar a choileanas am pròiseact amasan an sgeama agus mu chomasan an tagraiche airson am pròiseact a thoirt gu buil. Bu chòir foirmichean iarrtais a bhith soilleir agus glan.

Thèid foirmichean-iarrtais am measadh le panail, air a bheil riochdairean bho Bhuidheann Rùnaire an Oilthigh agus Ceiltis & Eòlas na h-Alba.

Assessment criteria:

Projects will be assessed according to the following criteria. Projects will be selected which:

- *raise the profile of Gaelic at the University.*
- *create opportunities for Gaelic to be used at the University.*
- *create or strengthen links with community groups.*
- *are new, innovative, or which add an additional facet to an existing event or project which fulfils the above criteria.*

Projects will be chosen which represent the most effective use of available funds. Applications should clearly demonstrate how the project will fulfil the criteria above as well as demonstrating that the applicants are capable of delivering the proposed project. Applications should be well-presented.

Projects will be assessed by a panel with representatives from the University Secretary's Group and Celtic & Scottish Studies.
